

SC Spikers Triumph by 77 to 53

Scoring sweeps in the high jump and broad jump, SC decisively defeated Occidental, 77½ to 53½, at Oxy yesterday forenoon to make it 81 consecutive dual track meets without defeat.

Four meet records fell in the varsity competition.

Glen Johnson of the Tigers put the shot 56ft. 5in., while Trojans accounted for the other new marks.

3:12.8 Relay

Charlie Dumas topped the high hurdles in 14.2, Bobby Staten scampered the 220 dash in 20.9 and the mile relay quartet of Dean Balzaret, Ted Smith, Tom Anderson and Staten was clocked in 3:12.8.

Dumas and Staten chalked up doubles, the former also taking the high jump at 6ft. 9¼in., and the latter the 100 in 9.8.

SC also won the frosh meet which was staged simultaneously, 75½ to 54½, with Dallas Long stealing the entire show. The young giant of a shot-putter got a best toss of 61ft. 9¼in., making it his eighth put over the once magic figure of 60ft. He also won the frosh discus with a flip of 152ft. 5in.

Munn Doubles

Bruce Munn shared frosh honors with Long, the Trobabe speedster taking both sprints handily in 9.8 and 21.2, the latter a meet record.

Staten was terrific. About 50 yards along the 220 course, he was scratching his chest, then got down to business and shattered one of the meet's oldest marks, finishing a tenth better than Payton Jordan, now Stanford's track coach, did for SC 'way back in 1938. And in the anchor relay lap, Staten was clocked in 46.8.

With all the doubles and records, the crowd of some 4,000 yelled the loudest to-

ward the finish of the two-mile event, when Troy's Rene Rogers uncorked a terrific spurt to come from far back and win by a comfortable margin over Oxy's Russ Bennett and Bill Peck.

The Tigers lost points because of a leg injury which hampered hurdler Clarence Treat. He could do no better than third in the highs and withdrew from the lows.

Perhaps the biggest surprise of the program was Bill Jackson's failure to exceed 21 ft. 4 1/4 in. in the broad jump, where he boasts a best of 24 ft. 5 1/4 in. As a consequence, he finished third behind Trojan teammates Luther Hayes and Charles Lindsay.

Another Trojan jolt came in the javelin, where Mike Page finished out of the money with a poor (for him) wait of 213 ft. 9 in.

The vaulters appeared likely to continue all day as five cleared 14 ft. The event finally ended with Jim Brewer of SC and Ed Crouch of Oxy sharing first at 14 ft. 4 in., with Gene Freudenthal of the Trojans and Dave Servis and Tim Helms of the Tigers knotting at 14 ft.

Freudenthal jammed his right shoulder as he cleared 14 ft. and had to be helped from the field.
