

# SC TRACKMEN HOT IN W. TEXAS MEET

ODESSA, Tex., March 19 (UPI) — Mighty Southern California smashed seven meet records, won eight of 12 events and scored 102 points to beat Baylor, Houston and Ohio State in the university division of the West Texas relays today.

The powerful Trojans, who haven't lost a meet to a college team since 1945, didn't threaten any world records as expected, but they were more than a match for the others as Baylor scored 66 points, Houston 55 and Ohio State 29.

## Long Does 61-8¾

SC's Dallas Long accounted for one of the records with a shot-put toss of 61ft. 8¾in. And Charlie Dumas, the Trojans' lanky high jumper, cleared 6ft. 10in. and then disappointed the crowd of 7,000 by declining to go for the 7-ft. mark.

Mike Larabee, former SC great now running for the Los Angeles Striders, defeated Olympic ace Glenn Davis in the special 400 meters in 48.4.

## Trojans Hot

Bob Sbordone threw the javelin 234ft. 5¾in., Jim Brewer pole valued 14ft. 9in., Luther Hayes broad jumped 24ft. 7½in., the mile relay team ran a 3:14.9 and the 880-yd. relay team did 1:25.0 for the other marks set by star-studded Southern Cal.
