

TROJAN TRACKSTERS HUMBLE OXY, 80-51; TWO MARKS FALL

Two meet records tumbled and another was equaled yesterday afternoon as SC defeated Occidental about as anticipated, 80-51, in their dual track and field meet at Oxy.

Dallas Long put the shot "only" 61ft. 11¼in., but that exceeded the former mark by more than 5 ft. His Tro-

jan teammate, Bob Shordone, whipped the javelin 244ft. ½in. to make hash of another standard.

And still another of coach Jess Mortensen's proteges, Jim Waldron, skimmed the low hurdles in 23.4 to tie the 1953 performance of SC's great Jack Davis.

Shot-Put 'Slice'

Glen Johnson of Oxy, who finished second yesterday, held the old shot-put record of 56ft. 5½in., which he made last year. And the former javelin high was 223ft. 9in., by SC's Mike Page in 1958.

Long, who recently tossed the 16-lb. ball 64ft. 6½in., was hampered by a slice yesterday, most of his efforts taking off to the right to cut down his distance.

High jumper Charlie Dumas of Troy didn't bother to shoot for any altitude record, calling it quits for the afternoon after clearing 6ft. 9in.

Double Winner

Only double winner of the program was sprinter Doug Smith of the Tigers, who did the 100 in 9.7 and the 220 in 21.4 to vanquish Bruce Munn and Rusty Weeks both times.

Dashman Jim Bates of SC was sidelined by a leg injury, Angie Coia competed only in the relay and Bobby

Staten also passed up the meet to nurse a slight muscle pull.

The freshman meet went to Oxy by a 72-59 margin. Two meet records fell here, too, and a third was equaled.

Record Bettered

Brian Polkinghorne and Bob Pierce of the Trobables and Lou Jekel of the Cubs all bettered the 120-yard high hurdles mark of 15s. Polkinghorne won in 14.3. In the 880, too, the first three finishers all broke the record of 1:56.2. Dave Moon of Oxy did 1:54.8, Ted Eggleston of SC 1:54.9 and Dave Brown of Oxy 1:55.

Trobabe Rex Cawley tied the 100 mark of 9.7.

Cawley and Dixon Farmer of Oxy were busy boys. The former won the 100 and 220, took second in the broad jump, tied for second in the

high jump and ran on the victorious relay team. He skipped his favorite events, the hurdle races. Farmer won the javelin and broad jump, tied Cawley for second in the high jump.
