

# Troy Spikers Top AAWU Qualifiers

SEATTLE, May 27 (AP) — Dallas Long casually flipped the 16-lb. shot 58ft. 7½in. today to qualify—along with 11 other Southern Californians—for tomorrow's finals in the first annual Big Five track and field meet.

UCLA and Washington each took eight berths in the seven preliminary events run off to cull the field. California earned seven spots; Stanford six. In this inaugural meet for the new Athletic

Assn. of Western Universities each winning performance becomes a record, but no world or national marks were threatened.

Not even bothering to remove his warmup togs, Long got off one toss of 58ft. 2¼in. That was enough to give him first place in the shot-put preliminaries.

Jim Wade of Southern California never did get out of his warmups for the discus and settled for second place with a toss of 167ft. 8in. Leading the six discus qualifiers was Gerald Carr of UCLA with a best throw of 170-7.
