

# Cal's Siebert Upsets Cunliffe in AAWU 880

**Trojans Score 83½ Points to Win Meet;  
UCLA 2nd; Long Puts Shot 61ft. 3¾in.**

SEATTLE, May 28—Stanford's Ernie Cunliffe, America's leading Olympic hope in the 800 meters, was upset by California's Jerry Siebert today in the half-mile finals of the first annual Athletic Assn. of Western Universities track and field meet.

Siebert nipped Cunliffe at the tape in a thrilling duel. Both runners were clocked in 1:49.

SC, as expected, captured the meet with 83½ points. UCLA was second (52 points), while California (46½), Washington (32½) and Stanford (26½) followed.

Big Dallas Long of SC easily won the shot-put with a toss of 61ft. 3¾in. as the powerful Trojans took eight first places and shared top spot in two other events.

The Trojans capped their winning performance by up-setting previously unbeaten

California in the mile relay. Angie Coia, who had captured the 220, nudged Cal's Jack Yerman, the 440 winner, at the tape. SC clocked 3:11.9 to Cal's 3:12 flat.

Cunliffe passed up the mile and UCLA's Bob Holland finished with a burst of speed to beat Washington's Jack Larson in 4:08.8.

Other Trojan winners were Charlie Dumas in the high jump (6ft. 8¾in.), Jim Wade, discus (172ft. 9½.), Luther Hayes, hop, step and jump (49ft. 2¾in.), Bobby Staten, 220-yd. low hurdles (23.7) and Rene Rogers, three mile, 14:24.0.

In addition Hayes tied with John Kelly of Stanford in the broad jump at 24ft.
