Records Fall

Seven meet records fell and three others were tied in the SPAAU track and field championships at Occidental College last night.

The show stealer proved to be the 800-meter run, which Oxy's Jim Cervený won in the record-equaling time of 1:49.4. It was a blanket finish as Bob Holland of UCLA and Louis Rodriguez

of Cal Poly (SLO) took second and third with identical 1:49.7 clockings.

Milford Dahl of UCLA and Bobby Seaman of the Striders also finished close up.

Walters Wins

Jerome Walters of the Striders set the 1:49.4 mark last year, but last night elected to go in the 1,500-meter run and bagged it in record time of 3:46.2.

Oxy's Doug Smith equaled the 200-meter record of 20.9 in the afternoon prelims but finished out of the money in the finals as SC's Angie Coia likewise did 20.9 to win. However, Smitty captured the 100-meter sprint in 10.4 to equal another meet standard, with Coia second.

Bob Sbordone of SC set a new javelin record when he wafted the spear 243ft. 11½in., Rudy Haiuza of the U.S. Air Force reduced the 3,000-meter walk mark to 13:52.7, Ray Hughes of Arizona shattered the 3,000-meter steeplechase standard with a 9:20.1 clocking, Ron Morris of the Striders vaulted 15ft. 1in., Bob Soth of the Striders ran 10,000 meters in

30:29.8 nd Rink Babka fired the discus 186ft. 3in.

Danny Murphy of Mira Costa High, while running in the 5,000-meter grind, was timed in 14:48.5 at the 3-mile post for a national prep record. The recognized record is 14:56.3. Murphy went on to place second in the 5,000 behind Oxy's Bill Peck.

On his last throw, Dave Davis captured the shot-put from Parry O'Brien, 62ft. 5 in. to 61ft. 6in.

After five events of the decathlon, the leader was Jim Klein of Santa Barbara AC with 4,046. Ron Jamison of the Striders is second at 3927, cleared 6ft. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ in. in the high jump portion, a district record for decathlon competition. Neither Rafer Johnson or C. K. Yang participated in the event, which will be completed this morning at 11 a.m.
