

Yang Stars in UCLA-SC Relay Meet

C. K. Yang provided the big bang as UCLA and SC got together in their annual relays meet at Westwood Saturday forenoon.

The Bruins' 27-year-old sophomore from Formosa set a meet record of 14 flat in the 120-yd. high hurdles, won the javelin throw with a 221ft. 7in. performance and achieved his all-time best pole vault of 14-5 in tying for first place with Troy's Jim Brewer.

Yang's previous highest "flight" measured 14-1 $\frac{1}{4}$.

Improves With Age

C. K., who finished second to UCLA's Rafer Johnson in the 1960 Olympic Games decathlon and hopes to capture the gold medal in '64, obviously improves with age.

The former hurdles mark of 14.4, set by Bob Lawson of SC in 1958, also was bettered by Trojan Bob Pierce, who was clocked in 14.3. Bruin Jim Johnson took third in 14.4, barely edging Brian Polkinghorne of SC.

The anticipated six-way battle in this event failed to materialize because minor ailments forced SC's Rex Cawley and UCLA's Billy Wells to scratch.

Other Records Set

Three other meet records were smashed, all by Trojan athletes.

Dallas Long put the shot 39-6, half a foot more than he did a year ago. And the four-some of Rusty Weeks, Jim Bates, Bob Pierce and Bruce Munn ran the 440 relay in 1:27.

The old marks were 41.9 and 1:27.2.
