

# Weightmen Star in Trojans Meet

Weightmen came through with some fine early-season performances Saturday as the Trojans and Striders staged a relays meet at SC.

Bob Humphreys of the clubmen wafted the discus 187 ft., 4½ in., and Jim Wade of the collegians did 177-11.

SC's Dallas Long pushed the shot 61-5 without undue exertion and Larry Stuart of the national AAU champions fung the javelin 234-3.

Bob Pierce of Troy bettered two meet hurdling records, but both races were

wind-aided. Pierce clocked the 120 highs in 14.2, as compared to 14.3 which Charlie Dumas did for SC in 1959, and then ran the 160 lows in 16.7, one-tenth faster than SC's Jim Waldron did last year.

Coach Jess Mortensen's 440 relay foursome of Rusty Weeks, Jim Bates, Bobby Staten and Bruce Munn was timed in 41.6, which equalled the meet mark set by those same sprinters in 1930.

## Faust Jumps

Joe Faust, who high-jumped 7ft. last year as a 17-year-old Occidental freshman and made the Olympics team, joined these Striders Saturday and proceeded to clear 6-9¾. He is now enrolled at UCLA, but is ineligible because of the transfer rule.

There was no official scoring, but SC would have won by 68-45 under ordinary dual meet conditions.
