

# SC Swamps Cal; Troy Hurdlers Set Meet Marks

One of California's weakest track and field teams met one of SC's strongest Saturday afternoon at Occidental College. The unsurprising outcome: 101½ points for the Trojans, 29½ for the Bears.

Two meet records were mangled by SC sophomores.

Bob Pierce ran the 120-yd. high hurdles in 13.9 and Rex Cawley clocked the 220 lows in 22.9. Each performance snipped three-tenths from the previous standard — and in each case the wind was an allowable 3.2 m.p.h.

Incidentally, Troy swept both races to lend further support to the claim that Cawley, Pierce and Brian Polkinghorne are the best three hurdlers on any one team in the country. Polkinghorne is a soph, too!

Another record was bettered, but it didn't count. SC's Jim Brewer twice vaulted 15ft. ½in., but both times

the pole went under the bar—and that's illegal. So he had to settle for 14-6, as compared with the meet mark of 14-9  $\frac{3}{4}$ .

Bruce Munn scored a double, winning the 100 in 9.8 and the 220 in 21.1 around a curve, which is moving right along. And Luther Hayes came through with a nifty broad jump of 24-7.

Dallas Long monkeyed around in capturing the shot put, as usual, with a "puny" distance of 59ft. 8 $\frac{3}{4}$ in., then revealed that he got married Tuesday. Mrs. Long is the former Barbara Littlejohn, an SC coed.

California scored only two firsts. Woody Covington took the mile in 4:17.7 and Alan Gaylord the two-mile in 9:12.4.
