

Trojan Trackmen Prance to Big Five Crown

STANFORD STADIUM—

What happened here Saturday must have been the nearest thing to solitaire in track and field history, particularly for a conference meet.

SC rolled up 101 points in winning the Big Five championship again. In the process, Jess Mortensen's mighty Trojans won 11 of the 16 events and shared

first place in another. UCLA scored 55, California 34½, Stanford 28½ and Washington 21.

Three of the SC athletes chalked up doubles.

Bob Pierce won the high hurdles in 13.9 and the lows in 23.0. Bruce Munn took the 100 in 9.8 and the 220 in 21.5, and Luther Hayes achieved his pair by broad-jumping 24ft. 10¾in. and hop-step-jumping 51-9¼.

What the carnage would

have been if Rex Cawley and Jim Bates could have competed is horrible to contemplate. Injuries kept them home.

Pierce shattered two stadium records along with meet marks. The best high-sticking ever accomplished here prior to Saturday was 14.0 and the fastest lows 23.2.

Hayes' "hop" performance was one of the best in the world this year and established a new school record.

His previous best, in 1960, was 50-11½.

Dallas Long treated the 2,500 sun-drenched fans to quite an exhibition of shot-putting. The Trojan strong boy easily won the event with 63-0½. His other efforts were 61-8, 61-7½, 62-3½, 62-10½ and 61-4.

Two mild upsets occurred when SC co-captain Bobby Staten edged teammate Kevin Hogan in the 440 with a 47.3 clocking and Trojan Bob

Sbordone out-slung UCLA's C. K. Yang in the javelin by slightly more than a foot.

The best race of the day materialized in the 880, where Andy Dunkell of UCLA made a gritty finish to overhaul Rick Klier of Stanford just before the finish. Dunkell, who fashioned a 1:48.9 last week, won in 1:50.8 Saturday.
