

TROJANS SNAP TWO RECORDS IN RELAY MEET WITH BRUINS

Despite icy blasts that had to come straight from the South Pole, two meet records fell Saturday morning as the UCLA and USC track teams jointly opened the season with their annual relays carnival at Westwood.

Both marks were racked up by Trojans.

Dallas Long put the shot 59ft. 9in. to better his 59-6 of last year. And Jan Sikorsky, back from a service hitch, flung the javelin 237ft. 6in.

The former javelin record of 223-5, set by USC's Mike Page in 1959, also was exceeded by C. K. Yang of the Bruins, who did 226-2½.

The spear tossing was particularly impressive, because the contestants were hampered by a stiff quartering wind.

USC won nine of the 13 events, though no point score was kept.

UCLA took only the broad jump, two mile 1 1, distance medley relay and two-mile relay.

Other top performances included: 14.2 by Bob Pierce in the high hurdles, 14-4 by Mel Hein in the vault and 163-7½ by Jim Wade in the discus. All are Trojans.
