

# Eight Open Marks Fall in L.B. Relays

Fine weather and a top notch entry list combined to make the revival of the Long Beach Relays a huge success Saturday.

Three thousand fans at Veterans Memorial Stadium excitedly watched the athletes rewrite the record book for this early-season meet, last staged in 1953.

Eight records fell in the university - open class and three others were set in new events. Similarly marks

were bettered in wholesale fashion in the lower grades of competition — colleges, college freshmen and junior colleges.

Although performances generally were far above average for this time of the year, there also were some startling disappointments.

For example, George Davies of Arizona State, who last summer set a world vaulting mark of 15-10-¼, went out at 14-9. Aburey Dooley, who had a lot to do with John Uelses' recent breaking of the 16 ft. ceiling as his amateur coach,

scratched after missing twice at 14-6.

Dave Davis who put the shot 62-3 a couple of seasons back went unplaced Saturday when his best effort measured only 53-3. Dave now is a marine stationed at Camp Pendleton and obviously has missed no mess calls.

### Pierce Fails

USC's Bob Pierce failed to qualify for the high hurdles finals and had to settle for a consolation flight victory. Gaston Green of Arizona State made it a double shut-out of the Trojans by besting Brian Polkinghorne in the finals with a fine 14.2 performance.

One of the days stellar exhibitions was made by world hammar throw champion Hal Connolly. The Pasadena Olympian clubber whirled the ball 224-9½, which wasn't too far off his all time record of 230-9.

On the track, perhaps the best effort was posted by an also-ran. The Striders finished third in the mile relay but Bob Karlsrud, the former University of California runner, came through with an anchor leg of 46.6.

Oh Yeah! The program, which involved more than 1,000 athletes, began at 9:30 a.m. and didn't wind up until after 5 p.m. and the press box lights burned far into the night.
