

# TROY BEATS OXY; HAAS IN DOUBLE

**Oxy Sprinter Beats USC's Munn in 9.5 100,  
21 Flat 220; Sikorsky Hurls Spear 250-5½**

Occidental sprinter Steve Haas finally beat USC's Bruce Munn Saturday as the schools staged their annual dual track meet at Oxy—and for good measure, the 21-year-old junior did it twice.

To the utter surprise of nobody, Troy won by a comfortable 78-53 margin. But Munn, after whipping Haas in three previous encounters, suffered very narrow defeats in the 100 and 220.

Haas took the 100 in meet record time of 9.5, with Munn also getting that clocking as he finished a scant foot behind. The old mark was 9.6, established 'way back in 1932 by USC's Frank Wykoff and equalled last year by Munn.

## **Wind No Factor**

The wind was no factor, being an allowable 2.9 miles per hour in back of the runners.

Munn led well into the stretch of the curved 220 course, only to have Haas draw up even and then win by about eight inches as both were timed in 21 flat. Since this race had been held on the straightaway until last year and then around a turn but checking out short, Saturday's time became a meet record.

## **Javelin Mark**

Incidentally, Oxy hired an engineering firm to determine accurate 220 lanes following two more fiascos this spring, so the race finally was official.

Two other meet records tumbled. Jan Sikorsky of USC whipped the javelin

250ft. 5½in. to better the 244-6 achieved by Bob Sbordone of Troy in 1960. And Ron Whitney of Oxy ran the 880 in 1:51.1, knocking three-tenths off the standard established by USC's Murray Cockburn in 1956.

Trojan Bob Pierce matched Haas' double by capturing the high hurdles in 14.4 and the lows in 24.4. The latter likewise became a meet mark because the event previously was contested on the straightaway.

Dallas Long, gradually warming up for an attack on the world shotput record, heaved the 16-lb. ball 63ft. 4in. on his first try, then surpassed 60ft. five more times in a fine exhibition of consistency.

That 63-4 was the big Trojan's best of the year.

Occidental never was going to win the meet, but probably would have done a bit better if Dixon Farmer and Richard Jones hadn't been hampered by slight injuries.

Oxy's frosh scored a thumping 78-47 decision over the Trobables.
