

MARIN RUNS 8:52; USC ROUTS FOES

Julio Marin, the little Costa Rican who set a USC school record in the mile (4:07) last week came back Saturday to set a two-mile mark of 8:52 as USC trounced Long Beach State and San Diego State in a three-way meet at Long Beach.

Marin broke Max Truex's 1958 mark of 8:54.8. The time was the best outdoors clocking of the young season.

Vault Record

The Trojans scored 124 points to 29 for San Diego and 28 for Long Beach.

San Diego's Daryl Nelson was the only non-Trojan to win an event, and he won two of them, the broad jump (24-4 $\frac{3}{4}$) and the triple jump (45-7 $\frac{1}{4}$).

Another new USC school record was set in the pole vault when Mike Flanagan soared 15 ft. 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ in.

Cortese Double

Winds aided the sprinters and hurdlers as USC's Dick Cortese won the 100 in 9.4 and the 220 in 20.4. Bob Pierce won the high hurdles in 13.9, outdueling teammate Brian Polkinghorne and

Long Beach's Dee Andrews.

Andrews, who was expected to win several events, hit a hurdle in the 330 intermediates, which also caused him to skip the triple jump, where he was favored.
