

TROY-HUSKY VAULT FIREWORKS FIZZLE

Anticipated fireworks in the pole vault failed to materialize Saturday as USC's talent-crammed track team overwhelmed Washington at the Coliseum, 106-49.

Brian Sternberg, the Huskies' sophomore sensation, won with 15 ft. 7 in., but didn't come close in three tries at 16 feet. In fact, he jiggled the bar hard in his winning effort, but it somehow stayed put. During the recent indoor season, Sternberg cleared 16-3½.

Cawley Stars

The Trojan pair of Mike Flanagan and Mel Hein Jr. had to settle for 15 ft. and Washington's John Cramer could do only 14-6.

USC's Rex Cawley, Brian Polkinghorne and Larry Stuart came through with fine performances.

Cawley took the 440 in

46.5, one of the faster clockings of the year anywhere, added the 330 intermediate hurdles in 37.2 and also ran on the winning 440 relay foursome. In the quarter, he edged teammate Kevin Hogan, whose time was 46.8.

Polkinghorne, whose 13.9 last week was the best 120 hurdles speed in collegiate competition this season, did 14 flat, though running into a 5 m.p.h. headwind.

Stuart whipped the javelin 245-1½.

Shinnick Leaps 24-6

Outstanding among the visitors, in addition to Sternberg, were Phil Shinnick and Waribuko West. Shinnick broad-jumped 24-6¾ to equal Washington's all-time record. West triple-jumped 48-3½ to land among the nation's leaders for 1963.

man John Yancy did 48-2¾ as the Trobables lost a simultaneous dual meet to Santa Ana JC, 68-53. Yancy also won the broad jump at 23-9½.

In the varsity competition, every meet record fell but those in the shot, two mile run and 100. And the latter was equaled by Troy's Dick Cortese, winner of both sprints in 9.8 and 21.3.
