

Only 808 See Trojans Trounce Bears, 97-48

Two meet records tumbled as USC's track team overpowered California, 97-48, at the Coliseum Friday night.

Attendance probably set another record in reverse. Only 808 fans braved the chilly weather.

Julio Marin of the Trojans covered the two miles in 8:51.6, fastest clocking of the year by a collegian. He erased the meet mark of 8:54.8 set by Max Truex of USC in 1958 and bettered his own varsity record of 8:52.0

achieved earlier this season.

The other record materialized in the pole vault where both Mike Flanagan and Mel Hein, Jr. of Troy went over at 15ft. 1½in. Flanagan was declared the winner of the event because of fewer misses, but both will share the new mark. The former standard was 14-9¾ by USC's Ron Morris in 1957.

Flanagan and Hein tried to clear 15-6½ and came close.

The Bears were weakened by the absence of Dave Archibald and Al Courches-

ne, who remained in Berkeley because of injuries.

Several of the Trojans scratched from certain events or else loafed through them because they will be active again today in the Mt. San Antonio Relays.

An upset was recorded in the high jump where Troy's Lew Hoyt, who cleared 7ft. ½in. recently, could do no better than 6-6 and second place. The event was won by Roger Olsen of Cal at 6-8. Olsen won the NCAA championship last year.
