

# Marks Set by Oerter, Ariz. St.

WALNUT — The 12,500 track fans who attended Saturday's Mt. San Antonio Relays program got their money's worth—and then some.

They saw two world records set, a third that was nullified by aiding wind. And they saw national and meet marks tumble like tenpins.

Al Oerter, 26-year-old New York Athletic Club Olympics veteran, upped his own world discus record from 204 ft. 10½-in. to 205-5½.

The Arizona State University quartet of Mike Barrick, Henry Carr, Ron Freeman and Ullis Williams "flew" the mile relay in 3:04.5 to smash the world standard of 3:05.6 set on the same track in 1960 by a United States Olympic squad combine of Eddie Southern, Earl Young, Jack Yerman and Otis Davis.

## Wind Helps Hayes

Bob Hayes, currently ineligible at Florida A&M, was clocked in 9.9 for 100 meters, one-tenth faster than the world record. But a tailwind of 11 m.p.h. helped him along — and the allowable limit is 4.47 m.p.h.

Oerter, competing for the first time this year, came through with a terrific exhibition which included five tosses over 200 ft.

His series was 201-5, 205-5½, 199-3½, 204-1½, 203-3 and 202-10.

Big Al understandably was voted athlete of the meet.

Carr contributed the fastest leg in Arizona State's feat. Barrick led off with 48-flat, followed by Carr with 45.1, Freeman with 45.6 and Williams with 45.8.

## Carr Second

Carr, incidentally, finished second to Hayes in the 100 meters as both he and John Gilbert of the Striders were clocked in 10.0, equaling the world record.

But that same testy wind, of course, also kept them out of the record book.

Hayes, exploding down the fast track, won by an estimated two yards.

Among the day's many other fine efforts was a 50.9 clocking by USC's Rex Caw-

ley in the 440 hurdles. It was the fastest time in the world this year.

San Jose State's John Garrison, Joe Neff, Harvey Franklin and Lou Davidson cracked the national freshman record for the two-mile relay by doing 7:34.4. The old mark of 7:37.5 was set by Occidental in 1960.
