

Day Nears U.S. Record; USC Wins

A freshman stole the show Saturday afternoon as USC and UCLA staged their annual trackfest at Westwood.

Bruin yearling Bob Day, from San Marino High, ran the mile in 4:05.7 to come within nine-tenths of a second of the national frosh record and shatter a 16-year-old meet mark.

The Trojan varsity, as anticipated, romped to a 99-46 victory, but the Brubabes came through with a wait-until-next-year win of 80-63.

Won By 40 Yd.

Day's fractions were: 60.8, 2:02.7 and 3:05.8 as he trounced Trobabe Bruce Bess by 40 yd. in what had figured to be a tight race. He also was clocked 10.4 faster than the varsity mile winner, UCLA's Tom Webb.

The national frosh record is 4:04.8, set by Mike Wiggs of Southern Illinois in 1961. And the ancient meet mark of 4:18.3 which fell belonged to none other than Louie Zamperini.

It was a tough day all around for Bess, who also finished second in the two-miler behind Brubabe Dave Carter. Day did not participate.

Double Winners

As 3,000 grandstanders plus TV viewers watched, double victories were achieved by Rex Cawley of USC and C. K. Yang of UCLA.

Cawley took the 440 in 47.1 to equal his own meet record and won the 330 hurdles in 36.5, his fastest time yet and just three-tenths off the momentary world mark of 36.2 made in this new event recently by Jim Miller of Colorado.

Yang won the broad jump with 23-10 and the vault with a meet record of 15-6. C. K. tried 16-3½, but failed. He also finished second in the javelin and third in the 120 hurdles.

Varsity Records

Other varsity records established were all made by Trojans. Larry Stuart threw the javelin 251-6½. Lew Hoyt high jumped 6-10 (and just missed at 7 ft.), Julio Marin ground out two miles in 8:50.2 and the mile relay team did 3:13.7.

In addition to Day, two other frosh broke meet marks. Mike Lindsay of the Brubabes vaulted 14-8 and Mike Parker of the Trobabes high jumped 6-7. John Yancy of the USC freshies won four events.

Cortese Upset

Perhaps the day's biggest surprise was Trojan Dick Cortese's defeat by teammate Dave Morris in the 100 as each did a wind-aided 9.7. UCLA's Arnold Tripp also got that clocking. Cortese later got even with Morris in the 220.

UCLA was left looking for its first varsity triumph over USC after 31 meetings.
