

TROJANS DOMINATE RELAYS CARNIVAL

USC's defending NCAA track champions made an auspicious outdoor season debut at Westwood Saturday morning as they virtually swept the card in the 10th annual Relay Carnival against UCLA.

Coach Vern Wolfe's Trojans won 10 and gained a tie in another of the 13 events in the traditional season opener, although no official score is tabulated.

The victors accounted for all the meet marks established, in the javelin, discus, two-mile and combined 3-man team shot put.

Javelin Record

Veteran Larry Stuart eclipsed his own spear tossing mark with a fling of 250 ft. 1 in. His old standard, set last year, was 239 ft. 5½ in.

Sterling Jenkins, national JC mile record holder from San Diego, reeled off a 9:02 2-mile to wipe out Max Truex's previous best of 9:26.6, made in 1958.

Another JC record holder, New Zealander Les Mills by way of Foothill, accounted for the discus mark with a spin of 173 ft. 8 in., beating the 172 ft. 8½ in. made by UCLA's Gerald Carr in 1960.

Record Team Shot

Although the shot putting wasn't spectacular, the Troy trio of Don Castle (56-8 ¾), Mills (56-1) and Dennis Wynn (52-7) combined for a record team total of 165 ft. 1-¼ in.

The Bruins' only running triumph came in the distance medley relay in which Gerry Mavrinnac, Dennis Breckow, Earl Clibborn and Bob Day combined for a fine 10:08 clocking. Clibborn contributed a 3:06.3 1,320 while Day anchored with a 4:14.2 mile.

In a series of shot put exhibitions, world record holder Dallas Long, ex-Trojan now representing the Pasadena A.A., had a best toss of 62 ft. 8-¼ in.
