

# Four Meet Records Topple as Trojans Overwhelm Oxy

Sweeping six events and capturing 14 of 17 first places, the powerful USC track and field team overwhelmed Occidental, 116-29, on a cold Saturday at Patterson Field.

Four meet records fell, with Occidental accounting for half of them despite winning only three events.

Coach Vern Wolfe's Trojans, tuning up for next Saturday's meet with New Mexico in Albuquerque, were heartened by two impressive performances.

## Bess in Form

Bruce Bess, rounding into shape after a two-month bout with mononucleosis, came from 20 yards back in the final 200 yards to nip teammate Dave Buck in 1:50.1. This wiped a full second off the meet 880 mark of 1:51.1, set by Oxy's Ron Whitney in 1962. Bess' best time since his illness had been 1:53.8 and his last lap clocking of 53.8 indicates he's ready for the big meets.

Chris Johnson, making his second start as a two miler, lowered his career best from 9:30.7 to a strong 9:02.9. Johnson was helped along in his eight laps by Chuck Schulz, a smallish Trojan freshman from Evanston, Ill., who finished in 9:11.1.

Occidental's two school re-

cord holders, pole vaulter Mike Graves and intermediate hurdler Vance Peterson, came through as anticipated. Graves cleared 16 feet 1/4 inch for the second straight week, while Peterson won the 330s in 36.6 to erase Rex Cawley's meet record of 37.1 set for USC in 1963. Another Bengal, Ron Hahn, also was under Cawley's mark with a 36.9 second place.

Mahoney Samuels set the other meet record with a 49-5/2 triple jump, while Paul Kerry's 14.2 high hurdles in beating Theo Viltz equaled the mark set by Charley Dumas in 1959.

The only other Occidental victory went to Dave Brown in the 440 when he outlegged USC's Hutch Gibb in 48.5. The pre-meet favorite, Trojan Dwight Middleton, did not compete due to a soreness in his thigh.

## Trobabes Collect

The USC freshmen also overran the Occidental yearlings, 111-33, and in the process uncovered a potential decathlon champion. Last year's state high jump champion from La Habra, Greg Heet, entered seven events, winning the 100 and high jump, placing second in the 220 and pole vault, third in the discus, and anchoring two winning relay teams for 19 1/2 points.

Trojan freshman javelin thrower Bill Bonnicksen not only set the only frosh meet record, he also exceeded the varsity winning distance. Bonnicksen threw the spear 207 feet 3 inches, while the best varsity toss was 195-5.
