

Samuels Sets Jump Record; Tray Breezes

USC made it 33 victories in 33 dual track meets with UCLA at the Coliseum Saturday afternoon—and added some lanky trimmings for 2,000 customers plus TV viewers.

Highlighting the Trojans' expected 53-52 win was a national triple jump record by Mahoney Samuels.

The 24-year-old junior from Jamaica first equaled the mark of 52 feet 4 inches set last year by Charlie Craig of Fresno State, then called 52-5. It was the longest leap in the country—probably the world—this year. Best previous 1963 performance was 52-0 3/4 by Lee Bond of San Jose State.

The wind machine registered zero during Samuels' feat.

Mahoney had a fine series, doing 48-10, 48-8, 52-3, 52-4, 52-4 and then 52-5. He fouled on his last try as the crowd groaned.

Five meet records tumbled and another was tied as USC captured both relays, scored a sweep in the high jump and bagged firsts in eight other individual events.

UCLA got some consolation by winning the companion frosh meet for the fifth straight year, 52-51.

Jackson Waves 'Em

Two Bruin varsity performers registered doubles, Bob Day taking the mile in 4:02.3 and the two-mile in 9:01.0, while Lee Dodson won the 100 in 18.8 and the 200 in 37.5.

Samuels' great performances overshadowed another outstanding Trojan effort. Sophomore Gary Carlson walloped the discus 190-8 1/2 for the second best collegiate effort of the season.

Four meet records materialized in the frosh competition—and the kibitzers went home raving about the form and speed of Brubake Norm Jackson, who equaled two meet marks and both times bettered the varsity performances. Though running into a headwind, Jackson was clocked in 9.7 for the 100 and 20.8 for the 200. He also anchored the 400 relay combine to a meet mark.

Another two-time winner among the yearlings was Roger Moody of the Trojans, who captured both hurdles races.

The 800 varsity run, as predicted, was a lulu. Dennis Carr of USC came from third place in the closing strides to nip Dennis Brockow and Arnd Kruger of UCLA.
