

Trojan Freshman Miller Zips 9.4 Against Wind

Speed and stamina shared top billing at the Long Beach Relays Saturday.

The swift was supplied by two university freshmen, Jamaican Lennox Miller of USC and Harold Busby of UCLA, who ran the open 100 in 9.4 and 9.5, respectively, despite a 10 m.p.h. headwind.

The staying power belonged to New Zealander Geoff Pyne of UCLA, who loped three miles in 13:34.6 to better his own school record (13:46) and contribute one of seven new meet records in the university-open class.

Ancient Record

Miller's great performance, by the way, equalled an ancient meet mark set way back in 1940 by Clyde Jeffrey of Stanford.

The early-season showdown between USC and UCLA in the two-mile relay produced a fast-paced 7:24.5 victory for the Trojan foursome of John Link, Bruce Bess, Dave Buck and Dennis Carr. The Bruins clocked 7:26, which also bettered the meet record of 7:26.4 set by the Westwooders last year.

Buck turned in the fastest leg of the race — 1:49.7 — while Bob Day of UCLA did 1:49.8. Day fashioned a nifty double by running a 4:02.7 mile in the distance medley relay.

Big Break

The most startling bit of record smashing occurred in the college class when Gary Ordway of Cal State Long Beach whirled the discus 172-10. That bit of doing bettered the listed mark by only 25½ feet!

Not all the action was confined to the stadium floor. Periodically during the afternoon, swarms of gnats buzz-bombed the customers, who fought a valiant but losing fight trying to shoo 'em away.
