

Six Records for USC as Huskies Swamped

SEATTLE (AP) — The Trojans of Southern California swamped Washington, 107-38, Saturday in a dual track and field meet that saw six meet records set—five of them by USC.

The Trojans won 14 of the 17 events in handing the host Huskies their

worst defeat ever in a dual meet.

The bright spot of the day for Washington was Al Pemberton's 186-4½ discus heave that set a meet, stadium and school record.

Paul Kerry, the NCAA champion hurdler, was the only double winner of the day, taking firsts for the Trojans in the 120 high hurdles and the 440 intermediate hurdles.

Southern Cal's John Link ran the mile in 4:05.3 to clip more than six seconds off the old mark.

Other Trojan records were set by Dennis Carr in the 880, Greg Heet in the high jump, Chuck Schulz in the two-mile and by the mile relay team.

Washington's main individual performer, Dave Williams, had an off day. He finished third in both the 120 highs and long jump and second in the 440 intermediates and triple jump.

"I did everything wrong today," he said.
