

# CARR TRAVELS 880 IN 1:48.5 AS TROJANS MAUL OXY, 113-30

A very sharp USC track team smothered Occidental, 113-30, at the Coliseum Saturday morning before an estimated 1,000 fans.

Only two meet records

tumbled, but the Trojans posted a succession of splendid performances that were all the more impressive because the weather was dark and chilly until the late stages of the meet.

Dennis Carr, pressured by teammate Dave Buck, zipped the 880 in 1:48.5, fastest time in the world this year. Buck's clocking was 1:49.5.

Carr's run not only erased Bruce Bess' meet record of 1:50.1 set last year, but also bettered the all-time school record of 1:49.6 achieved by Kevin Hogan in 1962. The 20-year-old junior was clocked in 52.7 for the first quarter.

## Triple Jump Mark

Mahoney Samuels accounted for the other meet mark when he triple-jumped, 50-5½ to surpass his 49-5½ of a year ago.

Dwight Middleton missed two meet records by one-tenth of a second when he won the 100 in 9.6 and the 220 in 21.1. Two other Trojans fell just a tick shy of meet marks as Bess took the mile in 4:04.8, and Paul Kerry the high hurdles in 14.3. Roger Wolff captured the 440 in 47.6 and Gary Carlsen threw the discus 184-6 1/2.

The Tigers, who did not enjoy one of their better days, were blanked in the pole vault, discus, high hurdles, and 220, plus losing both relays.

## Tiger Cubs Win

Chuck Kanoy, Oxy's top sprinter, scored only one point with a third in the 100. Dave Hickson failed to clear the opening height of 13 feet in the vault and Vance Peterson scratched from the 440 dash to concentrate on the 440 hurdles, which he won in 52.0. Oxy's only other victory came in the long jump on Bob Jones' 23-3 1/2.

The Tiger Cubs won the simultaneous freshmen meet, 81-64. There were two meet records by yearlings, both of them USC

athletes. Carl Trentadue did 4:09.7 in the mile, while Paul Wilson cleared 16-5 1/2 in the vault.

Andy Steban, finishing second at 15-7 1/4, set an Oxy freshmen record.
