Rick Sloan of UCLA soared to a world decathlon record of 16 feet 5 inches in the pole vault Saturday en route to victory in the SPAAU invitational decathlon at Mt. San Antonio College.

Sloan, a 20-year-old junior, ran up 7,869 points in the two-day competition. That total was the second best by an American this year, beaten only by the 7,880 by Bill Toomey in winning the National AAU championship.
