

McCullouch's Triple Sparks USC Victory

LOS ALTOS — USC's Earl McCullouch scored an impressive triple Saturday, breaking two meet records in the process, as the Trojan track and field team rolled over Stanford, 104-41, on the Foothill College all-weather track.

McCullouch won the long jump at 25 feet, 2 1/4 inches, the 120-yard high hurdles in 13.8 and the 220 around a curve in 21.4. His long jump and high hurdles marks were meet

records. He also ran a leg on the record-breaking 440-yard relay team.

Seven meet marks were broken, all by Trojans. They were:

McCullouch, 120 highs and long jump; Lennox Miller, 9.5 100; Geoff Vanderstock, 52.4 440 hurdles; John Link, 8:55.6 two mile; Bob Seagren, 16-6 1/4 pole vault, and the 440-yard relay team of McCullouch, Fred Kuller, O. J. Simpson and Miller, 40.0

In winning the 100, Miller erased one of the oldest marks in the books. Charley Paddock had set the meet mark at 9.6 in 1921 and it was subsequently tied by four other sprinters, including Mel Patton of USC (1948-49).

The Indians, who have not beaten the Trojans in a dual meet since 1933, were able to take only three first places — Jim Ward, in the 440 (47.8), Peter Boyce, high jump (6-10) and Ian Arnold, triple jump (48-1 3/4).

Troy's Dennis Carr, who has been running the two mile lately, stepped down to the mile and 880 and won both events. He was timed in 4:05.8 and 1:49.9, respectively.

The Trojans swept two events, the 100 and the pole vault.
