

Three Trojans Gain No. 1 World Ranking

Three Trojans, Neill Duggan, Carl Trentadue and Earl McCullouch, took over the world's No. 1 ranking in their events Saturday as USC ran over Occidental, 115-29, at Patterson Field.

Duggan, the 27-year-old English transfer student, set a USC record of 8:47.6 in one of the best collegiate two-mile runs in history. Jeff Marsee also set a USC freshman record of 8:57.4 in the race, while non-scoring Bob Deines of Occidental, back in fourth place, set an Oxy standard of 9:00.4.

Trentadue, one-time prep mile sensation who has been injured most of the past two years, ran the third fastest 880 in Trojan history, 1:47.9. He was only two-tenths of a second slower than Dennis Carr's school record.

McCullouch, despite knocking down one hurdle and tipping two others, raced over the 120 highs in 13.6, a time equaled Saturday by his football-playing rival from Tennessee, Richmond Flowers.

Oxy's Andy Steben won the pole vault at 15-6 as USC's Bob Seagren failed to clear his opening height (16-0) and Paul Wilson declined to compete because of a twinge in his calf.
