Trojans Set 7 Records in Routing Cal, 102-43

Powerful Southern California set five meet records and two stadium records in easily downing California, 102-43, in a dual track and field meet Saturday.

Earl McCullouch was

within one-tenth of a second of his world record in the high hurdles. He ran 13.3 to wipe out the stadium mark of 13.7 set by Olympic champion Lee

Calhoun in 1956.

McCullouch also particlpated in the 440-yard relay stadium record-shattering performance. He ran the first leg in the Trojans' 39.5 victory. The old stadium mark was 39.9 set by UCLA last year.

McCullouch wound up the day with a victory in the long jump at 24 feet.

The Trojans scored firsts in all but three events. Cal's Gary Pennington won the javelin at 227-7, Larry Hengl the 440 in 47.8 and the relay team the mile.

Six Negro members of Cal's team passed up the meet in deference to the memory of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. The group included 7-foot high jumper Clarence Johnson.

Cal coach Sam Bell said

they approached him individually late Friday afternoon and expressed their desire not to compete.

Other Trojans with meet record performances were Lennox Miller in the 100, 9.4, and the 220, 20.9; John Link in the mile, 4:05.1, and Ole Oleson in the two-mile, 8:47.1.

Cal's Bob Waldon set a school record of 8:51.6 in

the two-mile.
