SEAGREN WINS AGAIN AT CLAREMONT

Pole vaulter Bob Seagren staged a repeat performance Saturday in the Claremont Relays.

Seagren, the world record holder from USC, after clearing only 16 feet earlier in the day in the Trojans' dual meet with Occidental, made 17-2 at Claremont for first place.

A year ago, Seagren failed to make the opening height in the USC-Occidental dual meet and then drove to Claremont, where he won with a 17-01/2 vault.

"That smog was terrible," said Seagren, who won on fewer misses over Olympic teammate John Pennel, who also cleared 17-2. "I thought I was going to die on the runway." Seagren broke Pennel's 3-year-old meet record of 17-1.

Seagren passed until 17-2, clearing that height on his second attempt. Oxy's Andy Steben, who made 16-6 1/4 to defeat Seagren in the morning, cleared 16-6, but it was good for only third place.

Redlands' Jerry Proctor won his specialities in the college division - the long jump (25-71/2) and high hurdles (14.4), but went unplaced in the 100. Earlier Proctor was upset in the hurdle prelims when Fresno Pacific's John Veal tied the meet record of 14.3.

The Striders' Otis Burrell leaped 6-101/2 to set the only other open division meet record. Cal State (LA's) Stan Allotey (9.4 100) and the Striders' Tom White (14.0 high hurdles) equalled meet marks.

In the college division, Pepperdine's Lorenzo Russell and Ron Pettigrew set records.

Russell won the 100 in 9.4 and Pettigrew took the steeplechase in 9:23.4. Valley State's Rolfe Hoppe eclipsed the javelin record, throwing 235-4.

Pacific Coast Club won the open division team championship, Cal State (LB) took the College Division 1 title and UC Riverside was the College Division 2 winner.
