

# TROJANS RIP OXY, RUN 39.9 IN RELAY

Neither choking smog nor the unusual hour deterred the USC track team from performing with expected efficiency Saturday at the Coliseum.

When you wind up a Trojan track and field meet—even in a 10:30 a.m. meet—you usually come through. Such was the case as USC predictably swamped Occidental, 110-35, and set two meet records in the process.

The USC 440-yard relay team recorded the second-best time in the nation when it zipped to a 39.9 clocking, while Olympian Lennox Miller was an easy 94 winner in the 100 for the other meet mark.

A third standard was set by Oxy's Andy Steben, who upset world record holder Bob Seagren in the pole vault by negotiating 16-6 1/4. It was one of only four first places that the outmanned Bengals could muster.

## Franklin Impresses

The most impressive performer was sturdy Herman Franklin, who accounted for a difficult triple by winning the 120 high hurdles in 14.2, the 440 intermediates in 52.8 and the long jump at 23-5.

USC football coach John McKay refers to the 5-11, 180-pound Harbor JC transfer as the "roadrunner" and wants Herman to run for him again next fall.

Another football type to draw applause from the small pre-lunch crowd was freshman Edesel Garrison.

The former State prep quarter-mile champion from Centennial was a

relaxed winner in the 440 in 46.8 to place him among the top 10 on the all-time Trojan list.

Garrison was just running for the exercise, though, as he was a non-scoring contestant.

USC coach Vern Wolfe was pleased at his team's showing inasmuch as it was only its second outdoor dual meet of the season.

"I'm going to have to revise my estimate on that relay team," he smiled. "They're going to run faster this year than I thought they would."

Having performed so well in the a.m., you wonder what the Trojans might eventually accomplish in the p.m.
