

Garrison Romps

Big Edesel Garrison of USC was an easy winner in the 440 in 46.7 as UCLA freshman John Smith was far back in fifth in 48.8, just behind Biola's Musa Dogom Yaro.

Olympic champion Willie Davenport, marking time until he becomes a professional football player in the summer, appeared eased up in 13.8 as the Striders' Tommie White nearly caught him in the 120-yard high hurdles. Davenport had a three-yard lead over the last hurdle, but White's closing rush also gave him a 13.8 clocking.

Bill Toomey carries a strong 4,214 points into the final five events of the decathlon today. The Olympic gold medal winner ran a 10.7 100 meters, long jumped 24-4 1/4, put the shot 46-1 3/4, high jumped 6-4 3/4 and ran the 400 meters in 48.3.

"I'm not feeling too hot right now," Toomey said after completing the five events. "My left thigh (which was heavily taped) has been hurting all week. I'll give it a good try tomorrow, though. The first event, the high hurdles, will be the big test. If I don't think it will hold up I think the best idea is to take a good long rest and try again late in the season."

The decathlon starts today at 11 a.m.
