

Deckard Wins 100, but Loses in 220; Smith Wins Kennedy 440

BERKELEY — Willie Deckard of USC won the 100 in 9.4 and anchored the Trojans to a 39.6 victory in the 440 relay but suffered his first 220 loss of the season Saturday in the Kennedy Games at Edwards Stadium.

Don Quarrie of the Striders, a Jamaican who won three gold medals in the Commonwealth Games last year, defeated Deckard handily in the 220, winning in 20.5. Deckard, who owns the fastest time of the year at 20.2, was second in 20.7.

Quarrie, a transfer from the University of Nebraska, now attends USC and will be eligible next year.

In the 100, Deckard defeated Kentucky's Jim Green, considered to be Deckard's chief challenger in the NCAA championships at Seattle, June 17-19. Green also was timed in 9.4.

John Smith of UCLA won his second straight major race in the 440, edging USC's Edesel Garrison. Smith's time was 46.1, the same clocking he posted in winning last week's Modesto Relays.

Tom Gage of the New

York Athletic Club, became the third best hammer thrower in U.S. history with a throw of 233-6. Gage is a 28-year-old chemical engineer in Baton Rouge, La.
