

Trojans Win Team Title in Easter Relays

SANTA BARBARA — The USC 880-yard relay team saved the Easter Relays from complete mediocrity on an extraordinarily beautiful day Saturday.

As transistor radios carried the news of another UCLA basketball victory, the equally invincible Trojan relay tandem sprinted to a new meet record of 1:22.3 on a slow dirt track at La Plaza Stadium. USC won the team title with 82 points.

The Trojan relay unit, substituting Lance Math for Edward Garrison from the USC team that set a world record of 1:22.1 at the Coliseum three weeks ago, won by nearly 40 yards.

Anchorman Don Quarrie ran 18.8 on his 200-yard leg when he could have walked home and won. USC coach Vern Wells, asked how much sharper Quarrie could get, smiled and said that the Jamaicans Quarrie and fellow sprinter Willie Deckard, who also ran on the relay team, were far from top form.

Quarrie and Deckard also ran on USC's winning 440 and mile relay teams. Quarrie, who was named the outstanding athlete of the meet, fouled up the second baton pass in the 440-yard relay when he failed to accelerate quickly enough to receive the baton.

In the mile relay, Quarrie ran a rare 440-yard leg and died a slow and painful death the final 110 yards before he handed the baton to Deckard, who ran an impressive 47.7 leg.

But it was Quarrie's performance in the 880-yard relay that made USC's record time, won him the meet outstanding individual award and brought him nearer the stature of Tommie Smith and Henry Carr as a top 200 man in track and field history.

Jean-Louis Savignone, the world's No. 2 100-meter man last year from Madagascar, stopped the 100-yard dash Saturday and confined his running to relays for Westmont College. He looked impressive but his team failed to win in the college divisions 440 and 800 relays.
