time bettered that of Trojans Don Quarrie and Willie Deckard who ran 9.4 and 9.5 in going 1-2 against Stanford. "Edmonson looked great," said Bush, "espe-cially since he had a false start against him. But he's not going to beat Quarrie and Deckard. They're too good."
