Among the lifetime bests by the Trojans were 52.2 by **Bob Coffman** in the 440 hurdles and 58-5½ by freshman **Mike Budincich** in the shot. "Mike should be over 60 feet in three weeks," says Wolfe. "He continues to get bigger and stronger." Budincich, 6-3 and 255, is strictly a sleeper. At South Gate High last year he threw the 12-pound shot only 62-9 3/4, more than 10 feet off the high school record . . . Best of the Bruins were **Milan Tiff**, with a meet record of 52-5 in the triple jump, and **Anthony Veney**, who came back from a disappointing 4:14.3 for third in the mile to win the 880 going away in 1:51.5, a lifetime best. "There's no reason he can't go under 1:49," said UCLA coach **Jim Bush**. Asked about all the absentees, "Bush said, "You can only field 30 men according to Pacific 8 rules. This was a chance to use a lot of kids who otherwise wouldn't have had a chance." . . . Wolfe said, "Obviously, UCLA was looking ahead. They're going into a real hornet's nest at Oregon."
