USC, UCLA Beat Stanford, Cal

USC routed Stanford, 113-30, and UCLA defeated California, 88-57, Saturday in a double dual track meet at Berkeley.

The Trojans, who meet the Bruins in two weeks at UCLA, looked sharper than their crosstown rivals. In 10 of

17 events, USC had better marks than UCLA.

Freshman Don Bryson and sophomore Russ Rogers of USC had lifetime bests, Bryson winning the triple jump at 53-2 and Rogers taking the pole vault at 17-11/2.

UCLA freshman Willie Banks also went 53-2 in winning

the triple jump against Cal.

USC's Rayfield Beaton won the 880 in 1:49.7, a seasonal best, while UCLA's Tony Veney ran 1:49.5 in finishing second to Cal's James Robinson who was clocked in 1:49.3

UCLA's Jay Meisler won the high jump at 7-1, a career

best, and Rory Kotinek was second at 7-0.

Ken Randle of the Trojans, excused from spring football practice by John McKay, won the 220 in 21.2 and helped the Trojans win both relays.

Benny Brown of the Bruins won the 440 in 47.0, then waged a stirring duel with Robinson on the anchor leg of the mile relay. The lead changed five times before Brown came on to give UCLA a 3:11.5 victory. Brown was clocked in 47.5. Robinson in 47.4.

UCLA's victory was its 34th straight, extending back to 1971 when it lost to USC, 75-70. USC's win was its 40th straight over Stanford which last beat the Trojans in 1933.
