CORVALLIS, Ore. (UPI)—Julie Brown set records in the one- and two-mile runs Saturday in pacing UCLA to the national women's track and field championship.

UCLA scored 89 points to beat defending champion Prairie View A&M of Texas, which had 71.

Assn. of Intercollegiate Athletics for Women records were broken in eight of the 17 events. UCLA accounted for four.

Brown cut more than 45 seconds off the two-mile record with a time of 10:11.20, breaking the old mark of 10:56.6 set last year by teammate Francie Larrieu. In the mile, she won in 4:40.58, nearly two seconds ahead of teammate Kate Keyes, who was second. Both were under the AIAW record of 4:45.8.

Brown also ran second in the 880-yard final and ran a leg on UCLA's 1,600-meter relay team which was disqualified for interference.

UCLA's Kathy Schmidt threw the javelin 198-1 to better the old record of 192 feet.
