

USC Under Wraps But Wins Handily

USC's track team, without James Gilkes and Trevor Campbell, swamped UC Irvine and Cal State Northridge in a tri-dual meet at UCI Saturday.

The Trojans beat UCI, 113-40, and Northridge, 133-20. Irvine beat Northridge, 102-52.

Gilkes, USC's top sprinter, was out with a minor groin pull. Campbell, a quarter-miler, is nursing a pinched nerve in his back.

A cold wind prevented any outstanding marks, but USC coach Vern Wolfe could still see progress through the blowing programs and hot dog wrappers.

"We're coming along OK," he said. "(Ralph) Fruguglietti's 189-plus in the discus in our second meet is a good mark. And so was Fred Shaw's 14-flat in the hurdles. He didn't do much for us as a freshman last year but now it looks like he's ready to help us."

Eighteen members of the Toyo University team from Tokyo competed as a non-scoring fourth team. Itsuo Takanezawa, Japan's national record holder at 17-9, cleared 17 feet.

Rich Graybehl was USC's workhorse. He took a second (47.8) in the 400 meters and ran on USC's two winning relay teams.

Troy's Mike Simmons won the 100 meters in a wind-aided 10.4 after Joel Andrews was disqualified for a false start.

In the 800, USC's Rayfield Beaton ran away and hid from UCI's Steve Scott and Tom Kovacich in 1:50.2.

UCI swept both the 1,500 and 5,000. Scott and Ralph Serna finished in a 3:56.0 deliberate tie and the same kind of finish occurred in the 5,000 when Bob Tillman and Serna clocked 14:26.0.
