

USC, UCLA Easy Track Winners

Powerful USC overwhelmed California, 100-45, and eased-up UCLA defeated Stanford, 89-56, Saturday in a double dual track and field meet at Stanford.

The win was the 42nd straight for the Bruins who meet the Trojans, May 1, at UCLA. In a double dual meet two weeks ago at Westwood, USC smashed Stanford, 100-35, while UCLA beat California, 79-65.

In Saturday's meet, a comparison of USC and UCLA marks gave the Trojans an 83-58 edge, but both coaches juggled their personnel, so there was no true indication of comparative strength.

Individually, USC had a bigger day. Coming through with lifetime bests were Darrell Elder, 195-0 in the discus; Mike Helsby, 239-11 in the javelin, and Mike Budinich, 61-10½ and Ralph Fruguglietti, 57-9¼, in the shot. Equaling his best in the 800 meters was Rayfield Beaton with a 1:47.1 in running second to Cal's James Robinson who set a meet record of 1:46.9.

In 10 of the 17 events, USC had better marks than UCLA, but surprisingly the Bruins were faster in the sprints. Dotson Wilson's 10.5 in the 100 meters and Bennie Myles' 21.0 in the 200 bettered the 10.6 and 21.2 clockings of USC's James Gilkes.

UCLA's Willie Banks, who had won six consecutive doubles in the
