Women Better 5 Meet Records

USC's Patty Van Wolvelaere, Evelyn Ashford, Tennessee's Jane Haist, and relay teams from UCLA and Prairie View A & M shattered meet records Thursday as qualifying began in the National Women's Collegiate Track and Field Championships.

Van Wolvelaere, the two-time Olympian, ran the 100-meter hurdles in 13.4 at UCLA's Drake Stadium, topping the seven-year-old mark of 13.5 set by Grossmont Col-

lege's Patrice Donnelly.

Ashford, the favorite in the event, ran 11.43 in her 100-heat, breaking the mark of 11.53 set by Cal State LA's Rosalyn Bryant in 1976.

Haist, a Canadian, threw the discus 168-1, bettering the women's collegiate meet record of 156-5 set by UCLA's Monette Driscoll in 1975.

Another meet record fell when the UCLA team of Ashford, Modupe Oshukoya, Debbie Roberson and Kathy Weston ran the 880-yard medley relay in 1:41.1.

Prairie View's team of Mary Ayers, Arthurine Gainer, Beverly Day and Essie Kelley clocked 3:40.3 to establish a meet standard for the mile relay. That time was 10.5 seconds better than the mark set by the same school last year.
