

# TROJANS' MULLINS WINS 400 IN 45.51

Sophomore Billy Mullins won the 400 meters in 45.51 seconds—the second fastest time in USC history—and the Trojans' sprint and mile relay teams recorded outstanding early season times Saturday to highlight a dual-triangular meet with Arizona State and Brigham Young at Tempe.

USC won its 15th straight dual meet by beating NCAA champion Arizona State, 77-62. However, BYU won the triangular with 63½ points to USC's 61½ and ASU's 56. No dual score was kept between USC and BYU, but unofficially USC won, 70-64.

The Trojan foursome of Kevin Williams, Mullins, Clancy Edwards and James Sanford were timed in 39.1 in winning the 440-yard relay. The race was hand-timed because the electronic timing device malfunctioned.

To put this time in perspective, USC won the sprint relay in 39.56 at the 1977 NCAA meet.

In the mile relay, a team of Rich Graybehl (47.9), Rayfield Beaton (46.4), Mullins (45.7) and Sanford (46.6) won in 3:06.6—fastest winning time in USC history. The Trojan school record is 3:06.13 set in 1976.

The Trojans won easily Saturday after Beaton burned off the opposition with his fast second leg.

As expected, Edwards won the 100 meters (10.34) and 200 (20.33) without being pressed.

Mullins, a transfer from West Los Angeles College finished ahead of ASU's Tony Darden, runnerup in the AAU 400 last year. Darden was timed in 46.20. Sanford, a USC freshman, was third in 46.22.

The Trojans weren't at full strength as sprinter Joel Andrews, distance runner David Omwansa, discus thrower Derrell Elder, long jumper Larry Doubley and javelin thrower Urpo Paananen did not accompany the team to Arizona.

Andrews, a member of USC's winning 400 and 1,600-meter relay teams in last year's NCAA meet, has a glandular infection. Omwansa has a sore leg. Doubley was left home because of a minor disciplinary infraction, according to assistant coach Ken Matsuda. Paananen's wife, Teija, just gave birth.

Other Trojans who made creditable showings were freshman James Walters, who won the 800 in 1:49.4 ahead of teammate Lloyd Johnson's 1:50.2, and walk-on Steve Funderburk, who was third in the javelin at 201-1. Ilpo Paananen, Urpo's brother, was second at 207-10.

The Trojans might have won the triangular if Graybehl hadn't been disqualified in the 400-meter intermediate hurdles because of false starts. Graybehl has run 49.96. The race was won in 54.22.

Arizona State's sprinters couldn't stay with the Trojans, but Sun Devil Ray Wicksell, who prepped at West Covina, won the 1,500 in 3:44.5, edging BYU's Henry Marsh (3:44.6).

USC competes in the San Jose Relays next Saturday and will try to break the world 800-meter record of 1:21.4 set last year by Arizona State.
