

USC'S RELAY TEAM DISQUALIFIED

FRESNO (AP)—USC's 800-meter relay team was doubly disappointed in trying to set a world record in the West Coast Relays here Saturday.

Despite a bad handoff on the first exchange, the Trojans were clocked in 1:21.8—just two-tenths of a second off the record. The judges ruled the handoff was outside the legal zone, which disqualified USC and gave the victory to Tennessee. The Vols finished in 1:23.4, well off their best of 1:21.7.

Tom Woods of Pacific Coast Club obliterated the Trojans high jump record by 2¼ inches with a leap of 7-5. He failed three tries at 7-6¼.

The 51st relays had one unprecedented development when the electricity went out. A few lights were restored within five minutes, so a junior college mile relay was run over the dimly lighted track.

The rest of the lights were back before any other events were run.

Two national junior college records were broken. Thuris Gibbs of San Jose high jumped 7-3¼ and Ruth Kleinsasser Caldwell of Citrus ran the women's 800 meters in 2:03.9.
