## USC Runs 800-Meter Relay in 1:21.12

The USC 800-meter relay team of Michael Sanford, Bill Green, Billy Mullins and James Sanford ran 1:21.12, third fastest mark of all time, to highlight a strong Trojan performance in the Aztec Invitational at San Diego Saturday.

No official team scores were kept, but the Trojans won the three men's relay events it entered (800, 1,600 and 3,-200) as well as the women's sprint medley.

Trojans Kevin Williams and Michael Sanford finished one-two in the 100-meter dash, in 10.58 and 10.64, and USC might have swept the event but Larry Doubley false

started out of the race.

Doubley won the long jump at  $25-5\frac{1}{2}$ , and USC's Tony Campbell beat former Olympian Rod Milburn in a special running of the 110-meter high hurdles. Both were handtimed at 13.6.

"The team that beat us is the best college team in the country," said San Diego State Coach Dick Hill. "We went in as hungry as a group of piranhas."

San Diego State won the men's 400 relay in 39.82 (USC did not run), and Deby LaPlante of the Aztecs won the women's 100-meter hurdles in 13.38, well off her American record of 12.86.
