USC's Billy Mullins ran the fastest 400 meters in the world this year-45.34 seconds-and James Sanford, the Trojans' star sprinter, won both the 100 and 200-meter dashes Saturday in a non-scoring track and field meet at USC's Cromwell Field.

Mullins, whose junior college credits currently are under NCAA scrutiny, ran in the outside lane and into a brisk headwind on the final straightaway to beat teammates Bill Green (45.81) and Rod Bethany (47.57).

Sanford won both sprints while running into a 9.4 m.p.h. wind to win the 100 in 10.48 and into a 2.7 m.p.h. wind in the 200.

USC's Larry Doubley long jumped a wind-aided, lifetime best of 27-11/4 to win that event. He had three other jumps over 26 feet, including 26-41/4 with an allowable wind.

John Powell, the former world record holder in the discus who is now an assistant track coach at San Jose State, won with a throw of 207-10.

USC senior David Omwansa doubled in the 800 and 1,-500-meter events, winning in 1.50.4 and 3.49.2. William Wang, a USC student competing unattached, finished second in both races.

USC's collegiate record-holding 400-meter relay team of Kevin Williams, Mullins, Sanford and Green, won in 39.44.

Former Trojan Lance Babb, competing unattached, won the 110-meter high hurdles in a Cromwell Field record 13.79, beating USC's Anthony Campbell (13.89).

Tim McDonald of Cal Poly SLO won the pole vault with a stadium mark of 17-6. Former Bruin Willie Banks, now jumping unattached, won the triple jump at 54-3¹/₄.
