

# After 37 Years, Cal Beats USC in Track

STANFORD (UPI)—California's Paul Bates leaped 52-5¼ on his third try in the triple jump Saturday to defeat Kenny Hays of USC as the Bears registered their first track and field win over the Trojans since 1943.

The Bears defeated the Trojans, 84-70, while UCLA overwhelmed Stanford, 120-33, in the double dual meet at Stanford Stadium.

Hays finished second in the triple jump at 52-4¾.

Another key Bear victory came in the discus as Dave Porath won the event with a toss of 189-1. Steve Montgomery of USC placed second at 177-3 and Cal's Tony Hill was third at 163-7.

On the bright side for the Trojans was a stadium and meet record for their 400-meter relay team of Philip Johnson, Billy Mullins, James Sanford and Bill Green. Their time was 39.00. The old stadium record was 39.6 set by the U.S. national team in 1962. The meet mark was 39.20 set by USC last year. Mullins later took the 100 in 10:39.

Larry Doubley set a meet record of 26-3¾ in the long jump. The old mark was 25-3¾ set by Henry Hines in 1971.

The Bruins' Eric Brown was a double winner. He took the 100-meter dash in 10.68 and 200 in 21.28. Stanford football star Darrin Nelson placed second in both events, 10.77 in the 100 and 21.45 in the 200.

The only Cardinal win was in the 800 and they had to share that. Stanford's John Schaer and Jeff West of UCLA tied at 1:49.3.

The Bruins' Mark Lewis got a meet record in the 3,000-meter steeplechase at 8:46.6 and teammate Mark Anderson set a meet record in the javelin at 254-2.

Cal's win was only the second over USC in 56 years.
