Lee Balkin of UCLA cleared 7-41/4 to set a school record in the high jump Saturday as the Bruins came from behind to defeat Arizona State, 79-75, in a Pacific 10 dual meet at Tempe, Ariz,

Balkin broke the record of 7-4 held by Rory Kotinek.

UCLA trailed, 46-31, after nine events and was still behind, 71-69, with two events left, the mile relay and high jump. The Bruins won the relay for a 74-71 lead. then Balkin clinched the win when he left the Arizona State jumpers behind by clearing 7-1%. He then went on to set the record.

This has to be the best comeback we've ever had," UCLA Coach Jim Bush said. "We were out of the meet but the kids just reached down and found something."

UCLA's Kris Lettow, a transfer from UC Irvine, was a double winner, taking the shotput at 60-21/2 and the dis-

cus at 182-3 At San Diego, USC's Tonie Campbell was a double winner in the Aztec Invitational, edging teammate Milan Stewart in the 110-meter hurdles with a clocking of 13.71 and taking the 400-meter intermediates in 51.51. Stewart was clocked in 13.78.

Mike Packer of the Maccapi Track Club won the javelin with a throw of 255-0. In the Long Beach Relays, the outstanding marks were 7-4 by San Jose State's Thurlis Gibbs in the high jump and 47.5 by Centennial High's Leonard Graham in
