

Plucknett Throws a World Record 233-7

MODESTO—Ben Plucknett set a world record in the discus and Brian Oldfield claimed the American record in the shotput Saturday at the 40th California Relays at Modesto Junior College.

Plucknett's toss of 233 feet 7 inches was nearly 10 feet better than his career best of 223-8 and broke the world mark of 233-5 set by Wolfgang Schmidt of East Germany in 1978 in Berlin.

"I know where I am physicaly and technically," said Plucknett, who was as surprised as anyone by his final throw. "It shouldn't really have happened."

The 6-7, 304-pound 27-year-old from San Jose credited a world class field that included John Powell, who finished second at 229-7, Art Burns and Mac Wilkins.

"The competition was here," he said.

many observers feel could be the best weight double of all-time.

Oldfield, whose heave of 72-3 broke the U.S. record of 71-8 $\frac{1}{4}$ set by Terry Albritton in Honolulu in 1976.

Oldfield was five inches short of the world record held by Udo Beyer of East Germany. Oldfield threw 75 in an International Track Assn. meet several years ago, but it's not recognized as a world record by amateur federations because he was competing as a pro.

Greg Foster of UCLA, who beat world record-holder Renaldo Nehemiah last week in Los Angeles, ran the fourth fastest 100-meter hurdles of all-time, outclassing the field in 13.18. His 13.10 against Nehemiah in the pepsi meet was the second-best in history.

In the feature event, the mile, Steve Scott took charge on the final lap to win in a disappointing time of 3:55.2. John Walker of New Zealand was second in 3:56.3

Tyke Peacock, the local favorite from Modesto JC, won the high jump at 7-4. James Frazier was second at 7-3 and Olympian Reynaldo Brown third at 7-2.

Robin Campbell of Stanford won both the women's 400 (53.24) and 800 (2:04.9), Francie Larrieu took the 3,000 meters in 9:09.4 and Kim Turner won the 100-meter hurdles in 13.29.
