## Cook Opens Track Season With a Win

Trojan sprinter Darwin Cook opened his outdoor track season with a convincing victory in the 100-meter dash Saturday in a nonscoring meet at USC.

Running into a slight headwind, Cook, a senior, won his race in a time of 10.37. He then joined teammates Michael Harris, Terry Ivey and Antonio Manning as USC won the 400-meter relay in a time of 40.09.

Sophomore Manning also won the 200-meter dash in a personal best of 20.92, while Harris won the long jump with a leap of 24-834. Doug Wicks cleared 17-0 to win the pole vault.

Other standout performers included former NCAA indoor high jump champion Brian Stanton and world-class hurdler Sam Turner, each of whom won their events.

Stanton, formerly of Long Beach City College and the University of Houston, won with a leap of 7-44/2. The 1983 indoor champion failed on three attempts at 7-61/2.

Turner showed his 1984 form as he
won the 110-meter hurdles in a
time of 13.4.

Ex-Trojans Hank Kraychir and Ken Hays also won their events. Kraychir posted a mark of 61-11½ to win the shot put, while triplejumper Hays won his specialty at 51-6.

The meet also saw the debut of the women's triple jump at USC and a Trojan record for the women's shot put.

women's shot put. Yvette Bates won the triple jump with a mark of 40-1, outdistancing her nearest opponent by six inches. Trojan junior Diana Clements set a USC record in the shot put with a throw of 49-5½, breaking the old record by almost four feet.
