

Trojans Wallop Bruins, 120-11

Southern California's terrific Trojan tracksters piled up the biggest winning margin in PCC, Southern Division, history yesterday in swarming over UCLA's Bruins, 120-11, at the Coliseum.

Worst previous shellacking was the 115-16 defeat the Trojans dealt the Bruins in 1939. And, needless to say, it was the most one-sided margin in the history of the cross-town series, which SC now leads, 18-0.

In routing the Bruins, the Trojans swept every race on the card, another PCC first.

The Westwooders received some consolation, though, when the Bruin Frosh trounced the Trobabe tracksters, 73 to 58. It marked the first time the UCLA Frosh had defeated the SC yearlings.

the Trojan camp yesterday was Half-Miler Wally Wilson, who had to forego last week's inter-sectional biggie because of a slight calf muscle strain. Making his second start of the season in the half, Wilson, normally a miler, racked up a new meet mark of 1m. 53.3s.

Big Bob Chambers, a favorite in the event, led most of the way, but Wilson grabbed the lead coming off the final turn and crossed the final marker five yards to the good. SC's Fred Wehking came in third, and all three Trojans bettered the old meet mark of 1m. 54.5s. set by UCLA's Frank Fletcher in 1947. Chambers was timed in 1m. 53.9s. and Wehking in 1m. 54.1s.

Bradley Takes Dashes

Otherwise the Trojans had most cause to cheer in the sprints as Johnny Bradley turned in his top times of the season—9.9s. and 21.2s. The Trojans swept both dashes even though Al Mejia, a consistent winner in the 100, was absent because of an accident in his family.

In addition to Wilson's new standard, there were two other meet marks set. SC's Dick Attlesey, one of the nation's best, skimmed over the high hurdles in 14.2s., to knock one-tenth of a second off Jim Humphrey's old meet standard. And UCLA got into the record busting act when Cy Young tossed the javelin 213ft. 8½ in., approximately one foot better than Bob Peoples' old mark of 212ft. 7¼ in.

Jim (Super Chief) Newcomb grabbed the mile in 4m. 17.6s., best time of his career, in the four lapper, and then made a surprise appearance in the two-mile, winning in 9m. 39.6s.

O'Brien's Record

In the yearling affair, SC's Parry O'Brien, former Santa Monica High football-track ace, broke his school frosh shot put record by one foot, throwing the 16lb. bulb 52ft. 2¼ in. The effort also erased Bob Van Doren's meet record of 50ft. 10¼ in.

Trobabes Jack Davis and Verle Sorgen shared individual honors as they performed ironman stunts. Davis scored 14 points as he nabbed the high hurdles in 15s., the lows in 25s., took second in the broad jump and third in the 220.

Sorgen tallied 13 points in annexing the broad jump at 22ft.

7¼ in., the 220 in 21.6s. and bagging a second in the century.
