

USC SCORES ANNUAL TRACK VICTORY OVER UCLA, 86-45

USC kept UCLA winless in their traditional track series Saturday afternoon at the Coliseum, posting a lopsided 86-45 score before 1,250 on-the-spot fans plus TV watchers. It was Troy's 30th triumph over the Bruins.

Simultaneously, however, the UCLA frosh smothered USC's yearlings, 82-48, to remove some of the sting.

Only one varsity meet record fell. In the pole vault, Mel Hein and Mike Flanagan of the Trojans tied at 14ft. 11 $\frac{3}{4}$ in., bettering 14-10 $\frac{1}{2}$ by the Bruins' George Roubanis in 1959.

Two Double Winners

Bruce Munn and Brian Polkinghorne achieved doubles for the winners, the former taking both sprints in 9.7 and 21.2, the latter both hurdles in 14.3 and 24 flat.

USC's Kevin Hogan shared two dead heats. He tied teammate Ted Doll in the 440 at 47.9, then tried the 880 and wound up even with another teammate, Warren Farlow, in 1:50.8. Farlow, though, relaxed for awhile in the stretch to watch Kevin at this unaccustomed distance.

It was a rough afternoon for C. K. Yang, all-round star of the Bruins.

He suffered a cramp while vaulting and withdrew, fell in the low hurdles, went unplaced in the high hurdles and broad jump, scratched from the high jump and got only third in the javelin.

Scores One Point

So Yang had to settle for one point, an all-time low for him.

One frosh record was broken and another equaled. Doug Calhoun of USC was clocked in 9:18.4 for two miles as compared to Trojan Fernando Leon's 9:30.7 of 1958. Calhoun easily took the measure of Troy's varsity ace, Julio Marin, in this combined race. Marin did only 9:21.5.

Randy Walker and Steve Lock of the Bruises cleared 6-4 in the high jump to equal that meet mark. In this event, Lew Hoyt of

USC, who has done 6-10, elected to pass the first three heights, then began competing at 6-4 and failed. That left him an also-ran.
